Cocktails

Aperitivi

These refreshing house concoctions are the perfect way to start your meal, or great to be enjoyed in the bar with a little cicchetti.

Garibaldi - Select, Giovanni's cold-pressed OJ and house bitters 12

The North meets the South in this simple yet delicious aperitivo.

Casablanca 75 - Gin, limoncello, limonata and Prosecco 12

Our spin on the classic 'French 75' cocktail, but given the Italian treatment.

L'Ombre (the shadows) - Tequila, pinot noir, agave, lime and pink grapefruit 12

Inspired by the tradition of drinking in the shadows of St Marks bell tower in Venice

'Spritz per Tutti!' - *Spritz for Everybody!*

With the warmer weather upon us, we reckon now's the time for a Spritz!

Veneziano 'Vaperol Spritz' - As much a part of Venetian life as the 16

Grand Canal itself, we recreate this wonderfully refreshing aperitivo with Aperol, Prosecco, mandarino liqueur, soda, olives and orange.

Siciliano - Our Bar Manager Andrea's favourite Spritz - *he is Sicilian after all.* 16

Made using Solerno blood orange liqueur, Campari, Prosecco and soda.

Fruity, bitter, sweet and well; just delicious.

Al Fresco - Limoncello, St Germain elderflower liqueur, white vermouth 16

mint and Prosecco. The perfect drink to sip and savour as the warm sunshine starts to gleam through the window.

Bacaro - Dry Lambrusco sparkling (*the good stuff*), Cocchi Americano 16

vermouth, grapefruit and a little soda, offer a fuller - bodied but equally satisfying alternative to the classic style or spritz.

Cocktails

Negroni & Friends (all \$12 from 10pm - 12am Friday & Saturday night)

The Venetian Negroni - Have you ever heard of 'Select' ? Fortunately, we have 18
and to our knowledge we are one of only a few bars in Australia serving it. 'Select' is an
aperitivo made in Venice. It's just a touch sweeter than Campari, meaning it makes
a super-smooth Negroni! Here we stir it down with Four Pillars 'Spiced' gin, and
Del Professore vermouth; be warned these are highly addictive!

The Spicy Nebrovski - For the chilli lovers amongst us; this drink is one 18
not to be missed. House-infused chilli vodka, Campari & Ancho Reyes 'Chilli' liqueur
are combined with Maidenii sweet vermouth and finished with Moroccan bitters.
Unconventional ? Yes. Delicious ? Absolutely.

The Casoni - created to honour 'Don Camilo', history tells us he was lucky 20
lucky enough to have enjoyed the first ever Negroni at Café Casoni many moons ago.
This tricked - up version brings richness and spice, with the use of Diplomatico
'Mantuano' rum, coffee infused Campari, Tawny Port and black walnut bitters;
all sirred down and finished with a secret treat!

The Gringoni - we 'picture' Sergio Leone sipping on one of these whilst filming 20
one of his iconic spaghetti westerns. Italy meets Mexico in this deadly and delicious
drink; made using smoky Mezcal, Agavero tequila liqueur, Campari, sweet vermouth,
and agave & grapefruit bitters. There's the good, the bad and the tasty!

La Contessa - This enchanting little sister of the classic style Negroni, delicately 18
side-steps Campari's front on bitterness through the introduction of Aperol. This is
mixed with a little gin of course, for botanicals, sweet vermouth for spice and PX sherry
for a rich smooth finish and voila! A drink fit for royalty.

Negroni D'oro (*The Golden Negroni*)- this is the well-behaved golden child of the 18
family and our take on a Negroni Sbagliato (the mistake). There's no mistakes here
though as we stir down Select Aperitivo with Martini Rosso and Italicus bergamot
liqueur, the gin is replaced with a Prosecco top to ensure good behaviour all-round.

Cocktails

Memories of Venice - '*Ricordi di Venezia*'

Bellini - No stay in Venice is complete without a trip to Harry's Bar for a Bellini. 16

We make ours in the classic style, crushed white peaches are stirred with Prosecco. Simple and delicious.

The Secret Garden (*Il Giardino Segreto*) - This vibrant and floral drink 18

is inspired by the stunning gardens that lay hidden throughout Venice. Limoncello, Grappa, Crème de Violette and elderflower combine with lemon and jasmine.

Casanova - A seductive drink paying homage to the greatest lover of all 16

time and a true Venetian icon. White rum, Solerno blood orange liqueur, rhubarb and lime are served tall, topped with Fever Tree organic ginger beer.

The Salt Merchant - Historically, the wealth of Venice was built on the 22

salt trade, a commodity with great value in years gone by. Hence the origins of the word 'salary' from the Italian 'sale'; workers would be paid in large bags of salt. Ardbeg, Averna, PX sherry and salt combine in this briny, decadent drink; evoking the flavours of the lagoon and paying tribute to these influential merchants.

The Pickering Cocktail - Paying tribute to the whiskey drinking, 20

cigar smoking Yank, Harry Pickering. Down on his luck in 1930's Venice, he befriended bartender Giuseppe Cipriani and so 'Harry's Bar' was born. Woodford Reserve Rye Whisky, sweet & dry vermouths and morello cherry liqueur are stirred down with apricot, honey & smoked hickory bitters; all served smokin!

Dorsoduro Daiquiri - here we draw on the heritage of Venice and its 18

control of the exotic spice trade many years ago. We use Select as a base (a Venetian version of Campari), and shake it up with white rum, lime, grapefruit and our own secret blend of exotic spices. This drink takes us back to sunny afternoons, sat on the banks of the Grand Canal, watching the world go by.

Cocktails

Twisted Classics and Originals

The Rocco Martini (*inspired by the Pornstar Martini*) 20

We'll presume you all know who Rocco Siffredi is but you just don't want to admit it? It's pleasure all the way here with vanilla infused Bacardi gold rum, passionfruit, lemon and pineapple shaken and finished with Prosecco.

Mr Monchito (*inspired by the Pina Colada*) 18

Named in honour of legendary bartender Ramon 'Monchito' Marrera, who created the original in Puerto Rico back in the '50's'. We have taken his original recipe and tricked it up a wee bit. Kraken spiced rum, mandarin, passionfruit & chilli shrub, coconut cream, lime and vanilla are all shaken and finished with pineapple. Sounds good ? Just try it.

Vaporetto Martini (*inspired by the one and only*) 22

A bar has to have a signature Martini right ? so here we are. Our version is both elegant and floral and does not stray too far from the classic style. We stir down Tanqueray '10' with Cocchi Americano 'Rosa' vermouth and grapefruit bitters; the orange zest to finish to brings out the natural botanicals of the gin and it's all served ice cold of course.

South of the Grand Canal (*inspired by the Southside*) 18

Our take on this simple and refreshing classic is made using London dry gin as a base, shaken with Italicus bergamot liqueur, lime, sugar, Earl Grey tea syrup and finished with basil. Both zesty and floral, this is the perfect drink for any time of the day.

On Islay Thyme (*Original*) 22

We are definitely throwing out the rule book with this drink, to great effect. The intense flavours of smoky Mezcal and Laphroig 10 year old are shaken and mellowed with the addition of crushed pears, roasted rhubarb syrup, pineapple, lime and thyme syrup. Sit back, take your 'thyme' and enjoy.

The Diamond Fizz (*Original*) - for the sweet tooths amongst us, this drink feels 18

like sunshine in a glass. Aperol, dry vermouth, orange and lemon are shaken with kumquat 'marmellata' and topped up with Prosecco. Don't forget summer is coming.

Amarone grapes are dried naturally and slowly to intensify the flavours, through a process called 'Appassimento'. This process produces an intensely complex and textural wine, with tons of structure, sweet spice and a rich, balanced palate.

One of the very finest examples of Amarone you are likely to find anywhere. This family has been making Venetian wine for over 400 years and it shows. Again, taken from an exceptional vintage, this premium Amarone is produced from Tedeschi's prized vineyard in the hills of Pedemonte. Intensely fragrant and earthy with a deeply flavoured palate, this indulgent wine is a real treat.

Italian Wine Classifications

Along with the names of producers and grape varieties on Italian wines, you will see the terms DOC, DOCG and IGT. It is fair to say that most, if not all, quality Italian wines will belong to one of these classifications... so what do they mean ?

DOC (Denominazione di Origine Controllata) - This was the 1st Italian version of the French 'Appellation Controlee' system. It was introduced in the 1960s to protect the geographical origin of grapes, alcohol levels and production methods. Rules vary from one DOC to the next, examples are Soave and Valpolicella.

DOCG (Denominazione di Origine Controllata e Garantita) - Wines in this class must meet all the rules of their DOC, but will also be bottled in the region of production and will be graded by a government tasting board. Fiano di Avellino, Barolo and Chianti Classico are all famous examples of DOCG wines.

IGT (Indicazione Geografica Tipica) - This a term only introduced in the early 90's to cope with the increased volume of very high quality 'rogue' wines being produced, that did not adhere to the traditional DOC and DOCG rules of their region.
